History of the New Horizons Band

The first New Horizons Band was started by Professor Roy Ernst at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, New York in 1991 and is currently supported by a grant from NAMM International Music Products Association and the National Association of Band Instrument Manufacturers (NABIM). The word spread through articles in publications such as the *New York Times* and a feature spot on the *NBC Today Show*. There are now more than 120 New Horizons Bands in the United States with many more bands in the planning phase.

Playing music is a special joy and it will help you maintain mental and physical health. It is also a way of experiencing life. Playing music from the past keeps us in touch with those feelings; daily practice keeps us active in the present; striving for new goals attaches us to the future. New Horizons ensembles typically perform many times each year in venues ranging from formal concerts to shopping malls to parks to retirement and nursing homes.
